How the Big Four Ranked in the 2020 IPO Market

In 2020, 218 IPOs raised \$78.2 billion, with both the number of deals and their outsized average returns making it a historic year for IPO investors. While the COVID-19 pandemic sent global markets into a nosedive in March, the IPO window did not stay shut for long. Activity resumed at a rapid pace in the second half, dominated by healthcare and tech. The Big Four accounting firms appeared on 174 of the year's 218 IPOs (80%), which raised 93% of proceeds. Each saw greater activity than the prior year. With every offering requiring audited financials, there were 218 auditing engagements (466 including SPACs) with 23 accounting firms.

Ernst & Young appeared in the top spot again, auditing 53 IPOs which raised \$20.1 billion, mainly large tech and healthcare deals. **PricewaterhouseCoopers** remained in second place, serving on 45 IPOs that raised the most proceeds at \$26.1 billion. **KPMG** rose to third place, appearing on 39 deals that raised \$15.8 billion. **Deloitte** fell to fourth place, auditing 37 IPOs that raised \$11.0 billion.

While excluded below, SPACs had another record-shattering year, with 248 blank check IPOs raising \$75.5 billion. Withum and Marcum remained the most active SPAC auditors, serving on 138 and 93 deals, respectively. They were joined by 10 others, including KPMG and PwC (see pages 6-8). SPAC auditors often transition post-merger, but that could change if the Big Four expand further into the space.

53 IPOs \$20.1B

The most active auditor of the year, **Ernst & Young** worked on 53 IPOs that raised \$20.1 billion, primarily serving the healthcare and technology sectors. Six of its clients raised \$1 billion or more, including pharmaceutical royalty acquirer Royalty Pharma and online mortgage lender Rocket Companies. The firm also served on some of the year's top performers, such as high-flying COVID-19 vaccine developer CureVac and digital insurer Lemonade. While not counted in our list, EY also appeared on high-profile direct listing Palantir.

45 IPOs \$26.1B

PricewaterhouseCoopers took second place in 2020, auditing 45 IPOs that raised \$26.1 billion, the most proceeds of the quarter. It also audited one SPAC. PwC served on eight of the year's 20 billion-dollar IPOs, the most of any auditor, including the year's largest IPO, Airbnb. It primarily audited healthcare and tech, though it also served on several large consumer deals. PwC was the top auditor for Chinese issuers, including the year's five largest, among them fintech Lufax and EV makers Xpeng and Li Auto.

39 IPOs \$15.8B

KPMG saw the biggest year-over-year increase and rose to third place, auditing 39 IPOs that raised \$15.8 billion, plus seven SPACs. Its clients spanned nine industries, the most of any of the Big Four, and seven countries. Its top industry, healthcare, included health services providers, biotechs, and high-flying drug development platforms AbCellera, Berkeley Lights, and Schrödinger. KPMG served on eight tech IPOs, including meal delivery giant DoorDash, its largest deal, and Russian e-commerce platform Ozon. It also audited the year's two largest LBOs, "Big 3" music label Warner Music and data firm Dun & Bradstreet.

37 IPOs \$11.0B

The largest of the Big Four by revenue, **Deloitte** fell to fourth place, auditing 37 IPOs that raised \$11.0 billion. The firm primarily served on healthcare deals, which accounted for over half of its client base in 2020, most of which were biotechs. It audited two billion-dollar IPOs, contract research organization PPD and waste management giant GFL Environmental. Deloitte also worked on five technology IPOs, the largest of which was high-performing enterprise AI software maker C3.ai.

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Auditor Rankings for the 2020 SPAC Market

In 2020, blank check activity again reached new heights, with <u>248 SPACs raising \$75.5 billion</u>, and more waiting in the pipeline. The IPO alternative's growing list of milestones included the largest SPAC ever, Bill Ackman's \$4 billion Pershing Square Tontine, and the first SPAC to issue only common shares, RA Capital's Research Alliance Corp. I. SPAC specialists **WithumSmith+Brown** and **Marcum** audited 231 of the year's SPACs (93%) which raised 94% of annual blank check IPO proceeds. Outside of new offerings, 63 companies listed via SPAC merger in 2020.

SPACs also began to attract the larger players: **KPMG** audited seven SPACs in 2020, including The Gores Group's fourth, fifth, and sixth SPACs. **Grant Thornton** audited three insurance-focused SPACs, two of which were sponsored by Cohen & Company. Other SPAC auditors included **PricewaterhouseCoopers** (GS Acquisition II), **Frank Rimerman** (Ribbit LEAP), **Plante Moran** (FG New America Acquisition), **Kost Forer Gabbay & Kasierer** (ION Acquisition I), **BPM LLP** (GigCapital3), **UHY** (Ackrell SPAC Partners I), **Prager Metis** (Vistas Media Acquisition), and **dbbmckennon** (Petra Acquisition).

138 SPACs \$41.6B

Due to the record-breaking SPAC activity, **WithumSmith+Brown** was the most active auditor of the 2020 IPO market, auditing 138 SPACs that raised \$41.6 billion. The SPAC specialist's largest clients were both sponsored by Bill Foley: Foley Trasimene Acquisition I and II. It also worked on high-profile deals including *Moneyball* star Billy Beane's RedBall Acquisition and Casper CEO Philip Krim's Tailwind Acquisition. Four of the firm's 2020 deals completed business combinations and 15 ended the year with pending combinations.

Marcum audited 93 SPACs that raised \$29.1 billion, most notably serving on four of the year's five billion-dollar SPACs. Its largest client was Bill Ackman's \$4 billion Pershing Square Tontine, followed by Michael Klein's \$1.8 billion Churchill Capital Corp. IV. It audited several SPACs with notable backers, including Terrence Pegula's East Resources Acquisition and Chamath Palihapitiya's five latest blank checks. Four of Marcum's 2020 deals completed business combinations, with 11 pending combinations. The firm or an affiliate also audited two traditional IPOs, micro-caps Zhongchao and AMMO Inc.
